We are excited to announce that we will open the 2021-2022 school year with ***in-person learning for all students daily.***

In accordance with the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Hawaii Department of Health (DOH) guidance, our school will implement and layer the following mitigation strategies:

- All students will belong to an “Ohana Bubble” (cohort)
- Staggered pick up and drop off times will be established for students
- Each grade level will have separate recess and lunch periods
- Ohana bubbles will be assigned to designated areas on campus for non-instructional activities
- All students and staff will be required to wear masks
- Social distancing will be implemented to the greatest extent possible
- All classrooms will be sanitized daily

In late July, Wheeler Middle School will be hosting teacher meet and greet and schedule pick-up days. In an effort to reduce the number of people on campus, please adhere to your scheduled time slot. On this day, you will be able to pick up a hard copy of your child’s schedule, meet your child’s teachers, pay for student fees, and receive information about how to complete online bus and lunch applications.
